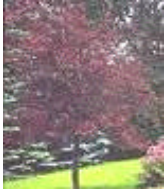


Flowering Trees



Northern Redbud *Cercis canadensis*

Heart-shaped leaves are preceded by an abundance of reddish purple buds that open rosy-pink. Mature height and spread 25' x 25'.



Chanicleer Pear *Pyrus calleryana 'Glen Form'*

Densely growing with white flowers. Much less susceptible to wind breakage than Bradford. Fall color is reddish. Mature height and spread 40' x 15'.



Snowdrift Crabapple *Malus 'Snowdrift'*

One of the most popular crabs. The crown is very uniform and symmetrical. White flowers in Spring. Mature height and spread 20' x 20'.



Canadian Red Cherry *Prunus v. 'Schubert'*

A very cold hardy tree, used for its foliage which changes from green in spring to dark purple as the weather warms, then intensifies to reddish in autumn. Mature height and spread 25' x 20'.

Shade Trees



Autumn Blaze Maple *Acer x freemanii 'Jeffersred'*

Fast growing red maple cultivar with long lasting fall color that is brilliant orange/red. Mature height and spread 50' x 40'.



Red Sunset Maple *Acer rubrum 'Franks red'*

Outstanding cultivar with upright branching, oval crown. Dark glossy foliage turns crimson red in fall. Mature height and spread 45' x 35'.



State Street Maple *Acer miyabel 'Morton'*

Excellent drought and cold tolerance and clean, pest-free foliage. Yellow fall color. Mature height and spread 50' x 35'.



Heritage River Birch *Betula n. 'Heritage'*

The bark exfoliates to expose tan, pink or orange colored younger stems. Yellow to gold fall color. Mature height and spread 40' x 35'.



Honey Locust *Gleditsia t. 'Imperial'*

Imperial is small and rounded, the most compact and formal of the popular Honeylocust. Yellow fall color. Mature height and spread 35' x 35'.



Bloodgood London Planetree *Platanus x acerifolia 'Bloodgood'*

The naturally shedding bark creates a dappled brown and cream pattern that accentuates sunlight filtering through. Yellow fall color. Mature height and spread 50' x 40'.



Swamp White Oak *Quercus bicolor*

Will grow very well in wet or dry soils. Attractive bark, large glossy foliage that turns purple-red in fall. Excellent for wildlife. Mature height and spread 60' x 60'.



Northern Pin Oak *Quercus ellipsoidalis*

Closely related to Pin Oak, this tree shares many positive attributes and is also more tolerant of dry and alkaline soils. Mature height and spread 55' x 40'.



Alee Elm *Ulmus parvifolia 'Emler II'*

Tall, upright and arching growth habit. Exfoliating bark creates a mosaic of orange, tan and gray. Yellow-orange to rust red fall color. Mature height and spread 50' x 35'.



Princeton Elm *Ulmus Americana 'Princeton'*

Has since proven to be one of the best American Elms for resisting the attack of Dutch Elm Disease. Yellow fall color. Mature height and spread 65' x 50'.



Bald Cypress *Taxodium distichum*

A deciduous conifer. Bald Cypress will grow well on both dry and wet sites. Attractive reddish-orange bark, and finely textured foliage. Mature height and spread 60' x 30'.
